Lenten Regulations:

- Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.
- Everyone 18 years of age & under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- Fasting on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday means eating only one full, meatless meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
